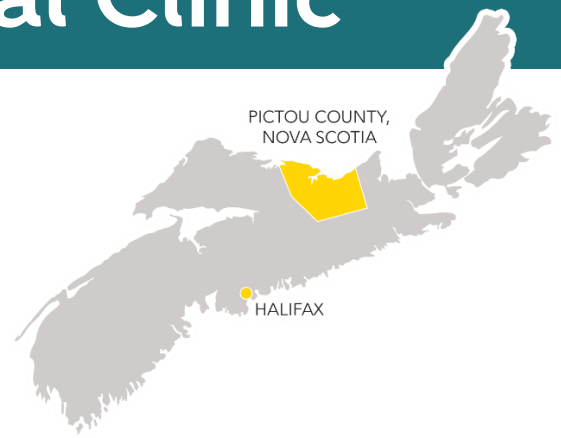
## On-call Rotation

Inpatient coverage for the group is covered with a rotating hospitalist arrangement, with each physician providing coverage every one in four weeks. For this clinic, part of those on-call duties also includes long-term care coverage. The group provides same-day patient access through the rotating 'duty doctor' arrangement. Typically, physicians do rounds first thing in the morning, before arriving at their practice to start seeing patients for the day.

The providers also work to cover reasonable vacation coverage internally.
