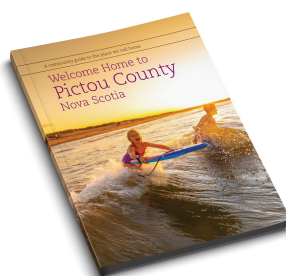
About our hospital and specialties

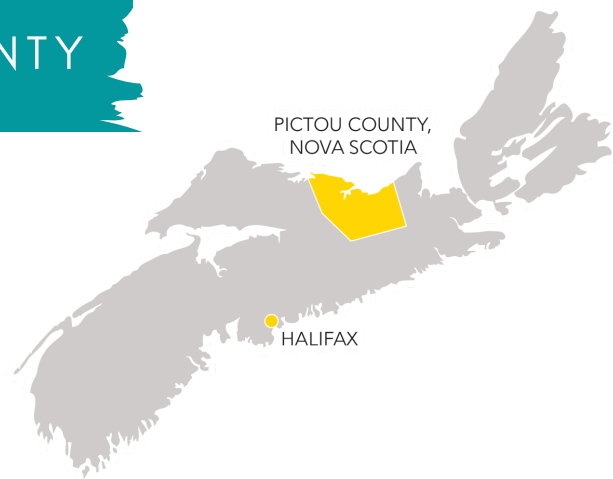
